

## PARENTS' STATEMENT

For your convenience in meeting your financial obligations, tuition is divided into **12 monthly payments**. The first payment is due on or before **June 1<sup>st</sup>**; the last payment is due on **May 1<sup>st</sup>**. ***I understand I am liable for a full month's tuition when my child is in attendance for 1 day in that month.***

I hereby pledge to pay my financial obligations to the school on the date due and understand that late fees will be charged if payment is received **after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month**. ***PLEASE NOTE THAT IF THE 15<sup>TH</sup> FALLS ON A WEEKEND OR HOLIDAY, YOU MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO HAVE YOUR PAYMENT IN THE OFFICE BEFORE THIS DATE. ANY PAYMENT RECEIVED AFTER THE 15<sup>TH</sup> WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE AND A LATE CHARGE WILL BE ADDED.***

I give my permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises.

I appreciate the stands of the school and agree to support all regulations of the school in the applicant's behalf and authorize this school to employ such discipline, as it deems wise and expedient for the training of my child.

I further agree to hold the school and its agents harmless of any liability to my child or any guardian or parent thereof because of any claims on behalf of my child against the school or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child. Should legal action for any reason, be taken against Northside Methodist Church & Academy or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf and the school or its agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay the attorney's fee, court fees, damages or other costs that Northside Methodist Academy or its agents should incur to defend itself against such action.

I also understand that participation is needed in lending practical help and prayer support in a mutual effort to train my child. Because of this, I will endeavor to attend Parent-Teacher Meetings and planned parent-teacher conferences unless providentially hindered.

I understand that the school reserves the right to dismiss any child who fails to comply with the established regulations and discipline or whose financial obligations remain unpaid. ***Accounts with outstanding balances at the time of withdrawal from the academy will be reported to the Credit Bureau.*** I understand that my child's grades or any other school records will not be released or transferred unless my school bill is paid in full.

I hereby give prior consent to the administrator of Northside Methodist Academy to notify the public school superintendent should my child cease attendance at said school.

## STUDENT STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Northside Methodist Academy holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Romans 8:29), which is the work of the Holy Spirit (II Cor. 3:18). This growth begins with the initial act of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the Biblical demands for the holy life that fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matt. 22:37-40; Romans 13:8-10; Galatians 5:14). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from the world.

Northside Methodist Academy must, therefore, provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people who are not yet mature Christians. A standard of conduct based on the following Biblical imperatives is necessary to provide such an environment. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us (I Cor. 8:9; 12-13; 10:31). The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well-being. (I Cor. 9:27).

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led NMA to adopt the following standards which it is believed are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the students. The school, therefore, requests each student – whether at home, school or elsewhere. . . .

1. to refrain from swearing, indecent language, gambling, disorderly and boisterous behavior
2. to maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, morality, and honesty
3. to be dressed modestly and appropriately
4. to refrain from the abuse or possession of drugs or alcoholic beverages
5. to refrain from the use or possession of tobacco products

(It is the school's belief that the sensual type dancing of today and the suggestive and explicit words of rock and heavy metal music does not promote the students' spiritual well being.)

Students are expected to abide by these standards while enrolled at NMA. Students found to be out of harmony with the NMA ideals of work and life may be invited to withdraw whenever the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct. In this atmosphere of definite and positive Christian standards of conduct, good scholastic planning, and intimate personal interest between faculty and student, there is fine opportunity for development of strong Christian character.
